

Proposed Bylaw Amendments - Results

The following bylaw amendments were proposed by the Council of the College of Dietitians of Manitoba (CDM) at the 2020 Annual General Meeting. Voting by members took place via the CDM website between October 28 and November 9, 2020 and resulted in approval of the amendments. The membership was notified of the results via email on November 16, 2020.

1) Bylaw Article 7.3 (Elections)

Purpose: to amend the CDM bylaws such that oversight of the elections of member directors is by the Governance Committee and not the Registrar. The Registrar reports to Council and should not be involved in election of the directors.

2) Bylaw Article 17.5 (Investment Authority)

Purpose: to amend the bylaw to permit investment of College funds in low and moderate risk investments. This change will provide flexibility to CDM Council to preserve capital and provide long term growth while ensuring stability without limiting the rate of return.
